| <p>It would seem to me that reality TV is nothing more than a form of sport. It's a competition, a game, but on a coast-to-coast basis it's more emotionally appealing than many of our sports. So I have to believe that as many people get interested in the reality show, they lose some interest in the old-fashioned sports.</p> | | | |
| <p>The constant problem that sports in this country suffer from is that there are just too many teams playing too many games. People, especially local fans, can follow their teams, but only the hard-core zealots monitor a whole sport. As a consequence, especially in the team sports with myriad games—baseball, basketball, and hockey—home attendance may remain high, while at the same time ratings for national games decrease. Raising house plants involves nearly as much care and knowledge as raising children. First, both plants and children are sensitive to their environments. For example, a plant will grow faster and be much healthier if it is raised in an atmosphere of tender care. The same is true for a child, who will be happier and healthier if her parents love and nurture her. Similarly, proper care of house plants requires the owner to have a basic knowledge of plants.
